COVID SAFETY INFO

COVID SAFETY INFO

Summernats 34 operates under a COVID Safe Event Plan.

Please read the below and follow the rules so we can all have a great event and look out for our mates, families, staff, and the community.

- You MUST wear a mask in all indoor settings.

- You are ENCOURAGED to wear a mask at all times at the event, particularly in situations where you are unable to physically distance from those unknown to you.

- DON'T COME if you're unwell, been in a hotspot, have COVID, or have been overseas or otherwise require quarantine.

- Check in using the Check In CBR app - download here.

- Use the hand sanitiser located in numerous places around the venue and practice good hand hygiene.

- Make yourself aware of the first aid facilities at the venue. The map can be found by clicking **here**.

WHAT IF I BECOME SYMPTOMATIC DURING THE EVENT?

Campers who become symptomatic are asked to leave the event and immediately return home, together with any other guests they have travelled with. This is because it is very difficult to isolate at EPIC whilst awaiting a test result, which could take approximately 48 hours. In addition, if the individual is a positive case it will not be possible for the individual to isolate at EPIC.

The ACT only has limited quarantine accommodation, and hotel accommodation is scarce. ACT Health advice is as follows.

1: Any campers who become symptomatic (no matter how mild) should leave the Summernats event immediately.

2: Individuals should pack their belongings whilst wearing PPE and practicing good hand hygiene and should not attend the broader event or any other public place in the ACT.
3: Individuals should advise event organisers that they are symptomatic and are leaving the event - so that appropriate actions can be taken in accordance with the event COVID Safety Plan.

4: Individuals should seek testing in an ACT Government facility as they leave the ACT. Details of testing facilities can be found on the ACT's COVID-19 website here.
5: Individuals should travel directly to their home, making only brief stops at isolated rest areas. They should wear a mask and practice good hand hygiene whilst outside of their vehicle.







SCRUTINEERIG

INFO

Every entrant vehicle goes through scrutineering. It's where you'll get your passes, stickers, and entrant pack. We've made some changes to get you into the action quicker than ever.

Summernats runs two scrutineering locations depending on whether your car arrives driving or on a trailer. Check your entrant tickets carefully for directions on where to go and when.

If your car is unregistered, you'll need a temporary permit. You'll get that at scrutineering, too.

Remember: Scrutineering times are subject to availability. Want the best scrutineering time? Enter early!



TRAILER PARKING

There is a free trailer parking area available on site at Exhibition Park meaning more room at the venue for entrant vehicles to cruise with ease. Please park your trailer here rather than leaving it inside the venue – trailers left inside the venue will be towed out, so save us the hassle.

WHO CAN DO IT

All entrant vehicles must be scrutineered.

WHAT TO BRING

Your car - looking its best for pre-judging. Your driving licence. Your tickets. Your helmet and fire suit if applicable.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Make sure your car meets the requirements. This is where you collect your entrant stickers, goody bag and arm bands. Driving event requirements must be met. Pre-judging occurs at scrutineering.

MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA

We are a Motorsport Australia sanctioned event. This means we operate under their safety and competition regulations.

Any entrant that wishes to take part in the event must comply with the Motorsport Australia standards.





SUMMERNATS FRINGE FESTIVAL BRADDON

INFO

The Fringe Festival will take place on Friday and Saturday nights during Summernats 34 in the Canberra CBD, where a large portion of Braddon (surrounding Lonsdale Street) is closed off for a Summernatsexclusive event. Enjoy music, food, cars, cruising and more.

WHO CAN DO IT

Passes for the Fringe Festival will only be given out to street-registered vehicles. All the normal road rules apply.

WHEN

The streets will be shut off to normal traffic from 6pm 'til 11pm on Friday and Saturday night, but the public can access the event free of charge on foot.

ENTRY & EXIT POINT

Entry and exit from Elouera Street.

WHAT TO BRING Your car and your passengers.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Normal road rules apply within the Summernats Fringe Festival Braddon. Pre-approved entrant vehicles only







CITY CRUSE





INFO

The Summernats City Cruise marks the official opening of the event and is a chance for select entrants to show off their ride to the city of Canberra. Participants drive in convoy from Exhibition Park into the centre of Canberra before a crowd of thousands, and then return to the venue.

LIMITED SPOTS AVAILABLE

The number of vehicles that can participate in the Summernats City Cruise is strictly limited. Entrants nominate to be part of the City Cruise when submitting their entry. We'll notify the lucky participants by email before the event.

WHO CAN DO IT

Entrants nominate to be part of the City Cruise when submitting their entry. We'll notify the lucky participants by email before the event.

ENTRY POINT

CANNA Main Arena from 9am.

WHEN Thursday 6th 12pm.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Normal road rules apply. 40kph speed limit. Watch out for vehicles, crossings, and people. Check out the Summernats City Cruise Guide.







INFO

Summernats has two burnout competitions, Burnout Masters and Burnout Championship.

Any entrant that wishes to take part in the event must comply with the Motorsport Australia standards.

BURNOUT MASTERS

Burnout Masters is the world's wildest motorsport competition. The best drivers, the toughest cars, and the biggest burnouts.

To compete in the Burnout Masters competition at Summernats, entrants must qualify at a feeder event during the year.



BURNOUT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Burnout Championship starts on Friday as we select the finalists for Sunday. The Top 30 will be invited back for Sunday's final. Entrants must be scrutineered for burnouts.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Drivers and passengers are required to wear a helmet that meets AS/NZS 1698 standard and a fire suit that meets or exceeds one of the following standards: SFI 3.2A/5 or FIA 8856:2000.

Drivers and passengers will be breath tested and must be under 0.01.

Access to the burnout pits is restricted to entrants and pit crew only.

WHO CAN DO IT

Entrants with a paid burnout time slot and qualified Burnout Masters.

WHEN

Thursday 6th: Wildcards 4pm-6pm.

Friday 7th: Burnout Championships Qualifying Friday 11am-4pm.

Saturday 8th:

Burnout Championships 11am-3pm. Master Qualifying 4pm-6pm.

Sunday 9th:

All Burnout Finals 1pm-4:30pm.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Be ready to go 15min before your time slot. Burnout Masters must qualify Saturday.





MEGUIAR'S PAVILION

INFO

Show off your hard work to the crowd and the Summernats judges and you could win one of a huge number of trophies and prizes. There are categories for all types of cars and an Elite category for the best show cars in the country.

JUDGING

Having your car judged by our panel of experts is a simple process. Check the event schedule for judging times and simply present your car to the judging pavilion looking its best.

Cars are judged in several categories including paint, interior, engine bay, engineering and more, with the best performers invited to take their spot in the Top 60 display.

MEGUIAR'S GREAT UNCOVER

The hottest new elite builds are unveiled at Summernats on Friday night at the Meguiar's Great Uncover.

WHO CAN DO IT

Any entrant can have their car judged.

WHEN

Scrutineering: Wednesday-Friday.

Meguiar's Judging Pavilion: Thursday 6th 10:30am-5:30pm. Friday 7th 8am-3pm.

Top 60: Friday 7th - Setup from 4pm.

WHAT TO BRING

Your car in pristine condition looking its best. Your display (for Top 60 - no bigger than 6x4 metres). Any lights must be tested and tagged.





SHOW N'SHINE

INFO

Want to show off your car but don't want to put it through the judging process? Park up on the CANNA Main Arena from 9am on Friday, Saturday or Sunday and let the huge Summernats crowd see the result of all your hard work.

HOW TO GET THERE

Follow the signs and head out to the CANNA Main Arena. Park up in the area indicated and enjoy the summer weather in Canberra. Want to park up with your mates or car club? Head out together and grab a good spot early!

WHO CAN DO IT All entrants can participate.

ENTRY & EXIT POINTS

Two entry points on either side of the venue. Follow the signs.

SUMMERNATS GRASS DRIVING COURSE



INFO

There are a bunch of ways to enjoy your car at Summernats, but one of the most challenging is on the CANNA Main Arena, tearing it up in the grass driving events.

Attack the course with a combination of horsepower and skill to see if you have what it takes when real wheelwork is required.

No passengers are allowed.

THE COURSE

The grass driving course (see maps) is the perfect chance for you to have some fun in your pride and joy. Whether you're going head to head or attacking the driving course, the main thing is study the maps follow the traffic cones!

WHO CAN DO IT

All entrant vehicles that have been scrutineered and meet the Motorsport Australia requirements.

Friday 7th 4pm-7pm. Saturday 8th 10am-4pm. Sunday 9th 9am-1pm.

ENTRY & EXIT POINT

Entry to the CANNA Main Arena is through Performance Park - follow the signs.

TUFF ST & SKID ROW



INFO

Tuff St is ingrained in Summernats folklore for its atmosphere. Spectators pack the area to witness some of the world's wildest machines parade up and down in both directions.

Skid Row, located in the Tuff St car park, is where entrants can turn tyres in a safe environment with a packed crowd watching on. You do not have to have your car scrutineered for burnouts to use Skid Row.

WHO CAN DO IT

All entrants who are allowed to cruise.

TUFF ST

The Summernats Cruise Route, which includes Tuff St, is operational from Thursday-Saturday 9am-10pm and Sunday 9am-5pm.

SKID ROW

Thursday 6th 1pm-8pm. Friday 7th & Sat 8th 11am-8pm. Sunday 9th 9am-1pm.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Seat belts must be on. No static burnouts. Obey all flags. Bonnet must be on.





SUPERCRUISE



INFO

The Saturday Supercruise is always a major highlight of Summernats. This is where entrants and their passengers can parade their pride and joy around the showground in front of thousands of onlookers.

WHO CAN DO IT

Invited Summernats entrants and other pre-selected vehicles.

WHEN Saturday 8th 7pm-8:30pm.

ENTRY

Enter and exit through Performance Park.

WHAT TO BRING

Your car nice and tidy. As many mates as you have seats and seatbelts.

INFO

Haltech Horsepower Heroes is a mainstay of Summernats and always attracts an awesome field of high horsepower vehicles and a crowd ready to witness record-breaking numbers. With multiple classes there's something for everyone and trophies to be won.

WHO CAN DO IT

Entrants who nominated at entry. You must also book a spot during the event (if available).

WHEN

Qualifying Friday 7th and Saturday 8th 9am-5pm. Finals Sunday 9th from 11am.

ENTRY & EXIT POINT

MPW Dyno Cell (Fitzroy Pavilion) off the Cruise Route.

WHAT TO BRING

Your car ready to rumble, free from leaks and running great.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Lock nut key for your wheels (hub dyno). Your best tune-up (there are prizes on offer). Register at the dyno cell early to secure your time.









INFO

Need fuel? Of course you do. Whether your car runs on premium unleaded, E85 or methanol, we've got you covered.

FUEL

You can't bring your own fuel with you to Summernats, (we'll check when you get here, so please leave it at home), but we run a fuel depot on the cruise route you can use whenever you need.

The fuel depot accepts card payment and is the only place you can refuel your vehicle inside the venue.

Make sure you tell us what fuel type your car runs on when you complete your entry and we'll make sure we have enough fuel to keep you lapping all event.

WHO CAN DO IT All entrants. **WHEN** Thursday-Sunday 9am-6pm.

Off the cruise route between the burnout pad and Skid Row.

No jerry cans can be filled. You must bring your vehicle to the filling station. No passengers.
