

Q: When can I camp?

Saturday 21st May 2022 only. There is no camping on Friday or Sunday night.

Access to camping is from Saturday 21st May at 8am only.

All campers and equipment must leave the venue by 5:30pm on Sunday 22nd May.

Q: Will there be toilets and showers?

Toilets will be provided. There are no showers on site.

Q: Will there be access to water?

Q: Will there be a caravan dump point?

Q: Can I bring my caravan or camper trailer?

Q: How are campsites allocated?

Campsites are allocated first in best camped

Q: Can I have a fire / fire bucket?

No. Fires are not permitted at camping.

Q: What can I bring?

- FOOD, WATER AND SOFT DRINK (strictly no glass).
- CAMPING GEAR - Eskies are allowed for food storage and must remain at your campsite. Fridges must be under 180L.
- GAS OR ELECTRIC BBQS - your gas bottle must comply with 2019 regulations and generators – please be mindful of your neighbours when in use.

Q: What can I NOT bring?

- GLASS / GLASS BOTTLES
- ALCOHOL

- FUEL & FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS - Jerry cans or Containers with flammable liquids, Paint cans, spray paint cans and nitrous oxide blubs or canisters will be confiscated.
- ANY UNAUTHORISED VEHICLES - No Motorcycles, motorised scooters or eskies, skateboards, drones or other unauthorised vehicles.
- ANIMALS
- FIREWORKS, FLARES & WEAPONS
- POOLS OR SPAS
- KETTLES, TOASTERS, FRIDGES OVER 180L, BUTANE GAS CANISTERS OR BURNERS
- ILLICIT SUBSTANCES
- *NOTE: All vehicles will be searched upon arrival.

Q: Can I move my vehicle

There is no vehicle movement allowed inside the spectator camping areas during the event period.

One camping vehicle is allowed per site and must remain on the campsite for the duration of the event.
