SCRUTINEERING

WHO CAN DO IT

All entrant vehicles must be scrutineered.

WHAT HAPPENS

Scrutineering is where you'll get your passes, stickers, and entrant pack.

CHECK YOUR ENTRANT TICKETS CAREFULLY FOR DIRECTIONS ON WHERE TO GO AND WHEN.

PRE-JUDGING

Your car will also be pre-judged at scrutineering.

IS YOUR CAR REGISTERED?

If you can drive it on the road, drive it to scrutineering — don't trailer it! It will be much quicker for you.

IS YOUR CAR UNREGISTERED?

You'll need a temporary permit. You'll get that at scrutineering, too.

MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA

We are a Motorsport Australia sanctioned event. This means we operate under their safety and competition regulations. Any vehicle participating in driving events will be scrutineered according to the Motorsport Australia Standards.

Check your ticket for your time slot.

THE ENTERED DRIVER MUST BE WITH THE VEHICLE DURING SCRUTINEERING — NO DRIVER SWAPS!

TRAILER PARKING

TRAILERS MUST BE PARKED IN TRAILER PARKING. There is a free trailer parking area available on site at Exhibition Park. **TRAILERS LEFT INSIDE THE VENUE WILL BE TOWED.**

SAFETY NOTICE

Please make sure you stay in your car at all times for everyone's safety.

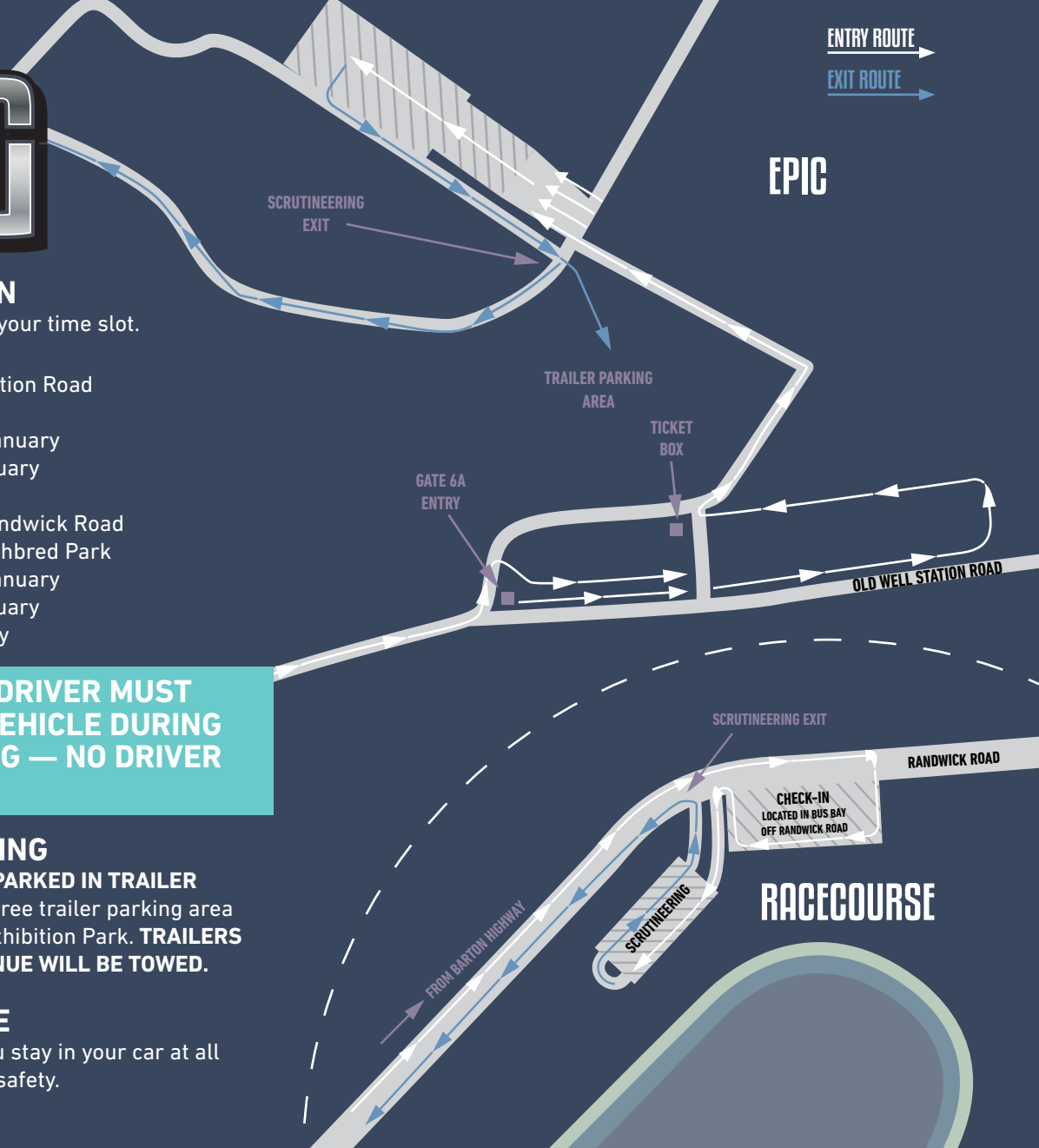
WHAT TO BRING

- Your **CAR** — looking its best for pre-judging
- Your **DRIVER LICENCE**
- Your **TICKETS**
- Your **HELMET** and **FIRE SUIT** if applicable

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Make sure your car meets the requirements
- This is where you collect your entrant stickers, goody bag and arm bands
- Driving event requirements must be met
- Pre-judging occurs at scrutineering

CRUISE ROUTE DO'S & DON'TS



✓ DO

Have fun and make the most of the opportunity to cruise and show off your car

Make sure you follow normal road rules as they still apply on the Cruise Route

Keep to the speed limit of 20km/h

Make sure all passengers are wearing seatbelts

Make sure that the entered driver is the person driving the car

Drive carefully and give way to pedestrians and stop at pedestrian crossings

Drive carefully when entering or exiting the Cruise Route

Listen to the security and officials on the Cruise Route — they are there to keep everyone safe

Make sure all children riding in the vehicle are in the correct child restraints

✗ DON'T

Burnouts — we have a zero-tolerance policy, and you risk losing your entrant rights

Let anyone else drive your vehicle on the Cruise Route — only the entered driver is permitted to drive their car

Drink and drive or you will have the Police to deal with

Ride in the back of a ute

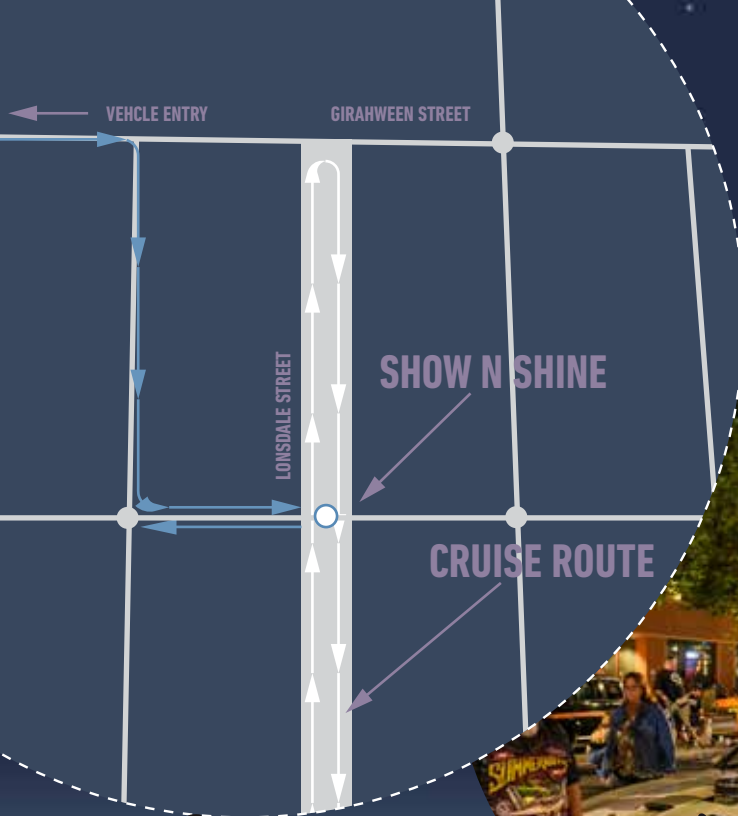
Cruise in a support vehicle, only entrant cars can cruise

Bring your trailer on to the Cruise Route — park it in the dedicated trailer parking

BRADDON FRINGE FESTIVAL



WHO CAN DO IT

Invitation only — passes for the Fringe Festival will only be given out to street-registered vehicles. All the normal road rules apply. You will receive a sticker an email prior to the event if you are successful.

WHEN

Friday 6 to Saturday 7 January
6:00pm - 11:00pm

FORM-UP

Invited festival vehicles will form-up from 5:00pm on both days.

ENTRY & EXIT POINT

Entry and exit from Elouera Street.

INFO

The Fringe Festival will take place on Friday and Saturday nights during Summernats 35 in Braddon for a Summernats exclusive event. The roads are closed to invited Summernats cars only, with the festival precinct open to the general public. Enjoy music, food, showing off your car, cruising and more.

WHAT TO BRING

- Your **CAR** and your passengers
- Make sure you have your driver wristband

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Normal road rules apply within the Fringe Festival
- Pre-approved entrant vehicles only

CITY CRUISE

INFO

The Summernats City Cruise marks the official opening of the event and is a chance for select entrants to show off their ride to the city of Canberra. Participants drive in convoy from Exhibition Park into the centre of Canberra before a crowd of thousands, and then return to the venue.

WHO CAN DO IT?

City Cruise is invite only, so you will already know if you've been selected. If you want to participate at Summernats 36, don't forget to nominate yourself when you enter!

FORM-UP

Form-up will be on the CANNA Main Arena from 9:00am. Make sure you're ready to go by 11:30am.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

A compulsory drivers briefing is at 11:30am on the stage in the CANNA Main Arena.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Follow the car in front of you
- Normal road rules apply
- 40kph speed limit

- Watch out for vehicles, crossings, and people
- Check out the Summernats City Cruise Guide
- Smile and have fun, there will be a lot of people watching and cheering as you drive past

BURNOUTS

INFO

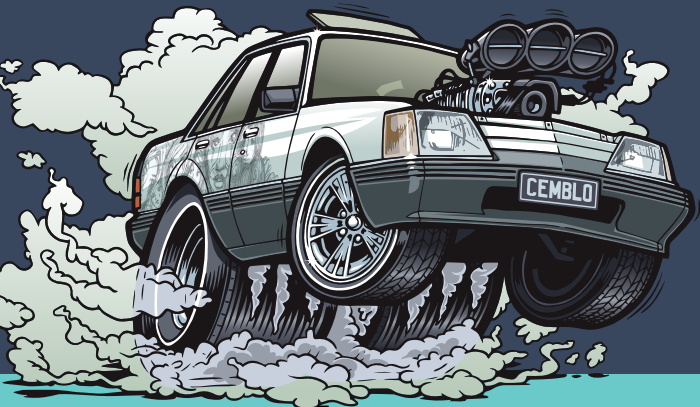
Summernats has two burnout competitions, Burnout Masters and Burnout Championship. Any entrant that wishes to take part in the event must comply with the Motorsport Australia standards.

BURNOUT MASTERS

Burnout Masters is the world's wildest motorsport competition. Our Masters have already qualified at feeder events during the year.

BURNOUT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Burnout Championship is open to entrants with a paid Burnout time slot. After qualifying the Top 30 will be invited back for Sunday's final. Entrants must be scrutineered for burnouts.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Fire suit meeting or exceeding SFI 3.2A/5 or FIA 8856:2000 as a minimum
- Drivers and passengers must be wearing closed-toe shoes
- Helmet meeting or exceeding AS/NZS 1698:2006 or UNECE 22.05 as a minimum
- The use of flame retardant balaclava, socks, gloves and shoes is highly recommended
- Burnout vehicles require a fire extinguisher complying with AS1841 minimum of 900g mounted or secured within the vehicle

WHAT TO BRING

- ☐ Passenger and driver **HELMET** and **FIRE SUIT**

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Be ready to go 15 minutes before your time slot
- Passengers must sign the Motorsports Australia Passenger Waiver
- No loose items in your car
- No bonnet? Fan shroud must be present and blower belt guard if required



Meguiar's PAVILION

INFO

Show off your hard work to the crowd and the Summernats judges and you could win one of a huge number of trophies and prizes. There are categories for all types of cars and an Elite category for the best show cars in the country.

JUDGING

All pre-judging will take place during scrutineering.

Cars are judged in several categories including paint, interior, engine bay, engineering and more, with the best performers invited to take their spot in the Top 60 display.

There are a bunch of ways to enjoy your car at Summernats, but one of the most challenging is on the CANNA Main Arena, tearing it up in the grass driving events.

Attack the course with a combination of horsepower and skill to see if you have what it takes when real wheel-work is required.

No passengers are allowed.

The grass driving course (see maps) is the perfect chance for you to have some fun in your pride and joy. Whether you're going head to head or attacking the driving course, the main thing is study the maps follow the traffic cones!

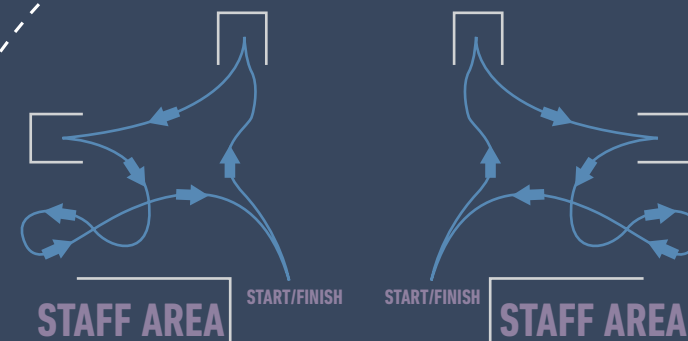
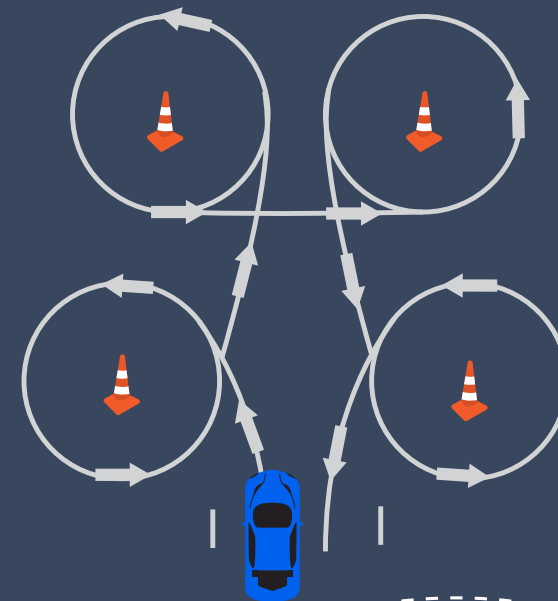

TUFF ST & SKID ROW

TUFF ST

Tuff St is ingrained in Summernats folklore for its atmosphere and is the best place on the Cruise Route to show off your car. Spectators pack the area to witness some of the world's wildest machines parade up and down in both directions.

SKID ROW

Skid Row is located in the Tuff St car park where entrants can turn tyres in a safe environment with a packed crowd watching on. You do not have to be scrutineered for burnouts to use Skid Row.

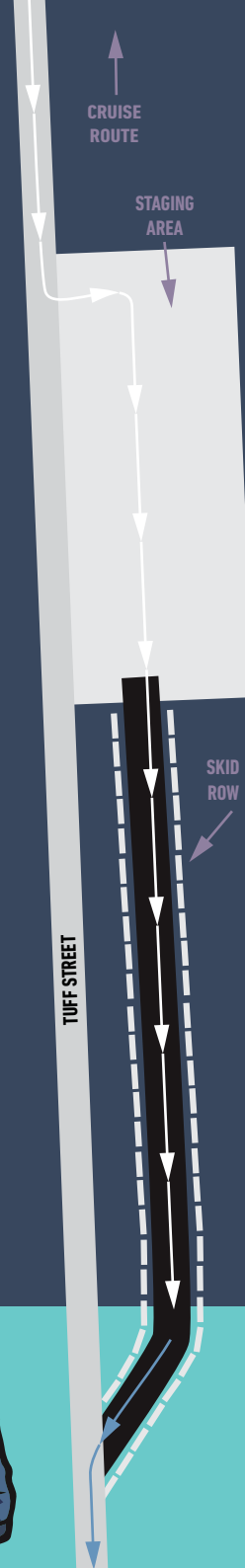
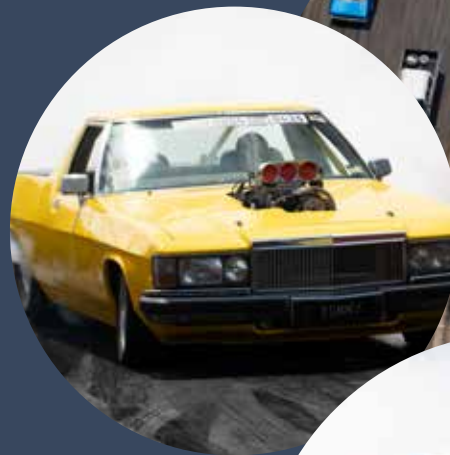

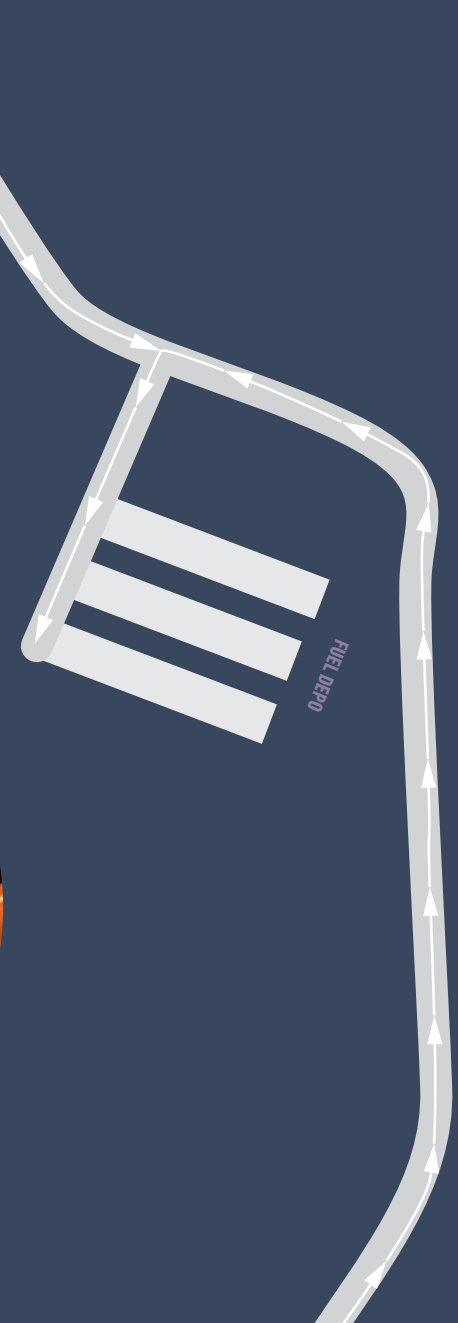
