

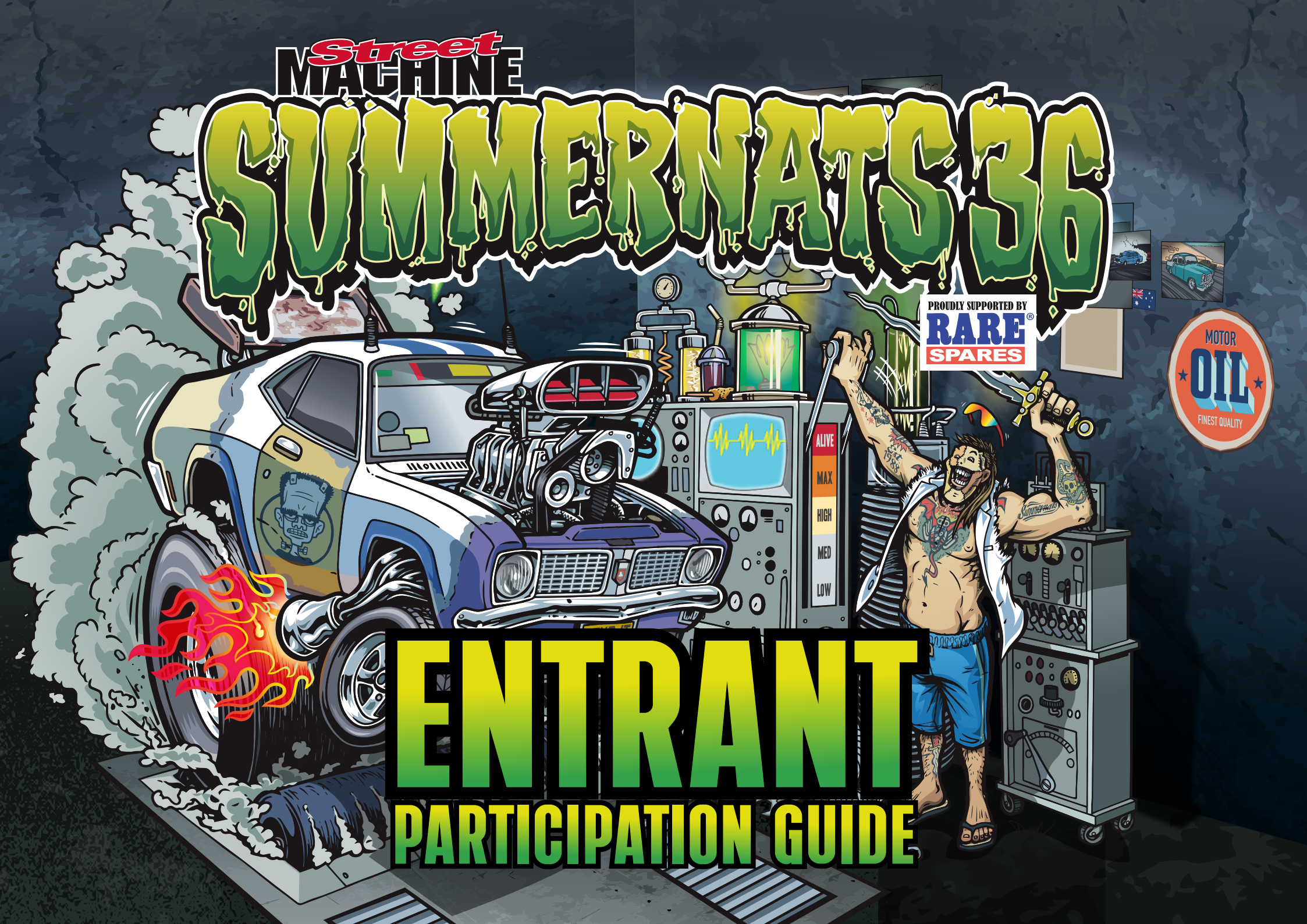

SCRUTINEERING

WHO CAN DO IT

All entrant vehicles must be scrutineered.

WHAT HAPPENS

Scrutineering is where you'll get your passes, stickers, and entrant pack.

PRE-JUDGING

Your car will also be pre-judged at scrutineering.

IS YOUR CAR REGISTERED?

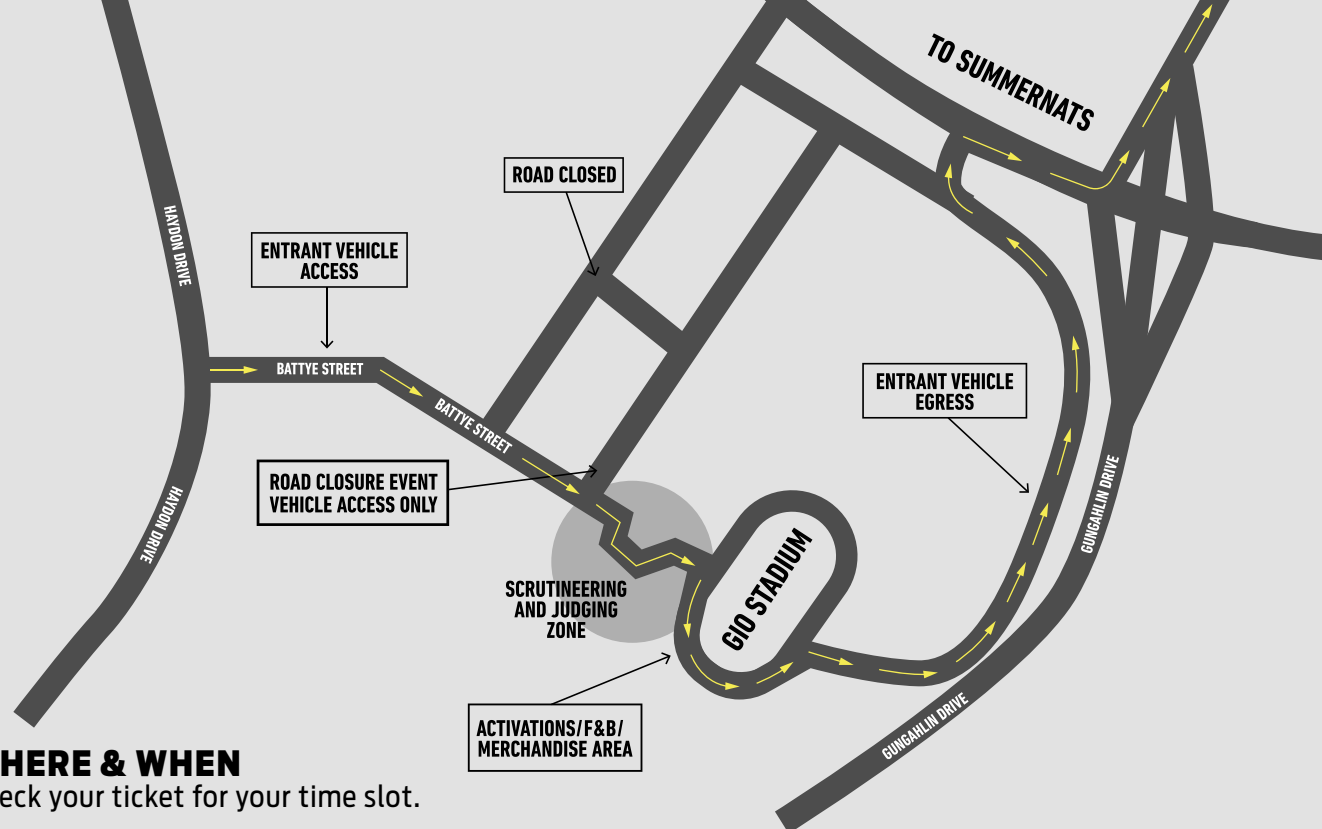
If you can drive it on the road, drive in to scrutineering — don't trailer it! It will be much quicker for you.

IS YOUR CAR UNREGISTERED?

You'll need a temporary permit to drive inside EPIC.

MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA

Summernats is sanctioned by Motorsport Australia. This means we operate under their safety and competition regulations. Any vehicle participating in driving events will be scrutineered according to the Motorsport Australia Standards.

TRAILER PARKING

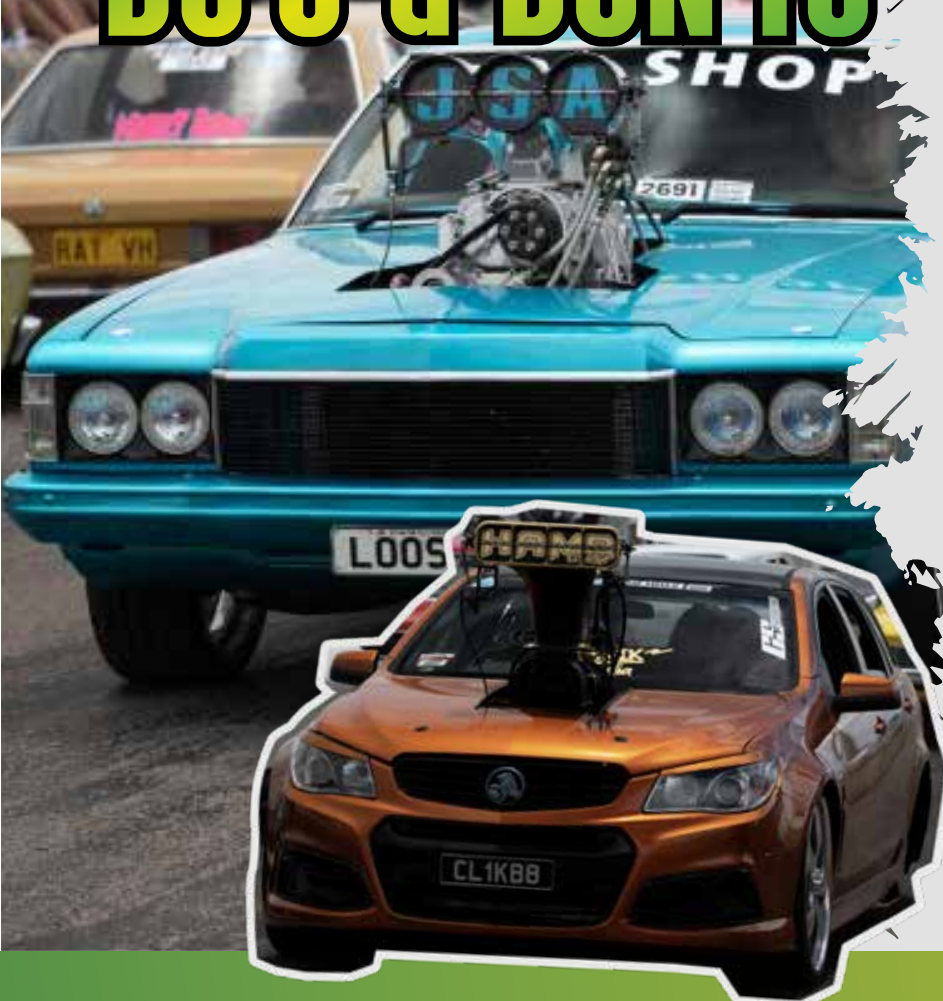

CRUISE ROUTE DO'S & DON'TS



✓ DO

- Have fun and make the most of the opportunity to cruise and show off your car
- Make sure you follow normal road rules as they still apply on the Cruise Route
- Keep to the speed limit of 20km/h
- Make sure all passengers are in seats engineered to the vehicle and wearing seatbelts
- Make sure that the entered driver is the person driving the car
- Drive carefully and give way to pedestrians and stop at pedestrian crossings
- Drive carefully when entering or exiting the Cruise Route
- Listen to the security and officials on the Cruise Route — they are there to keep everyone safe
- Make sure all children riding in the vehicle are in the correct child restraints

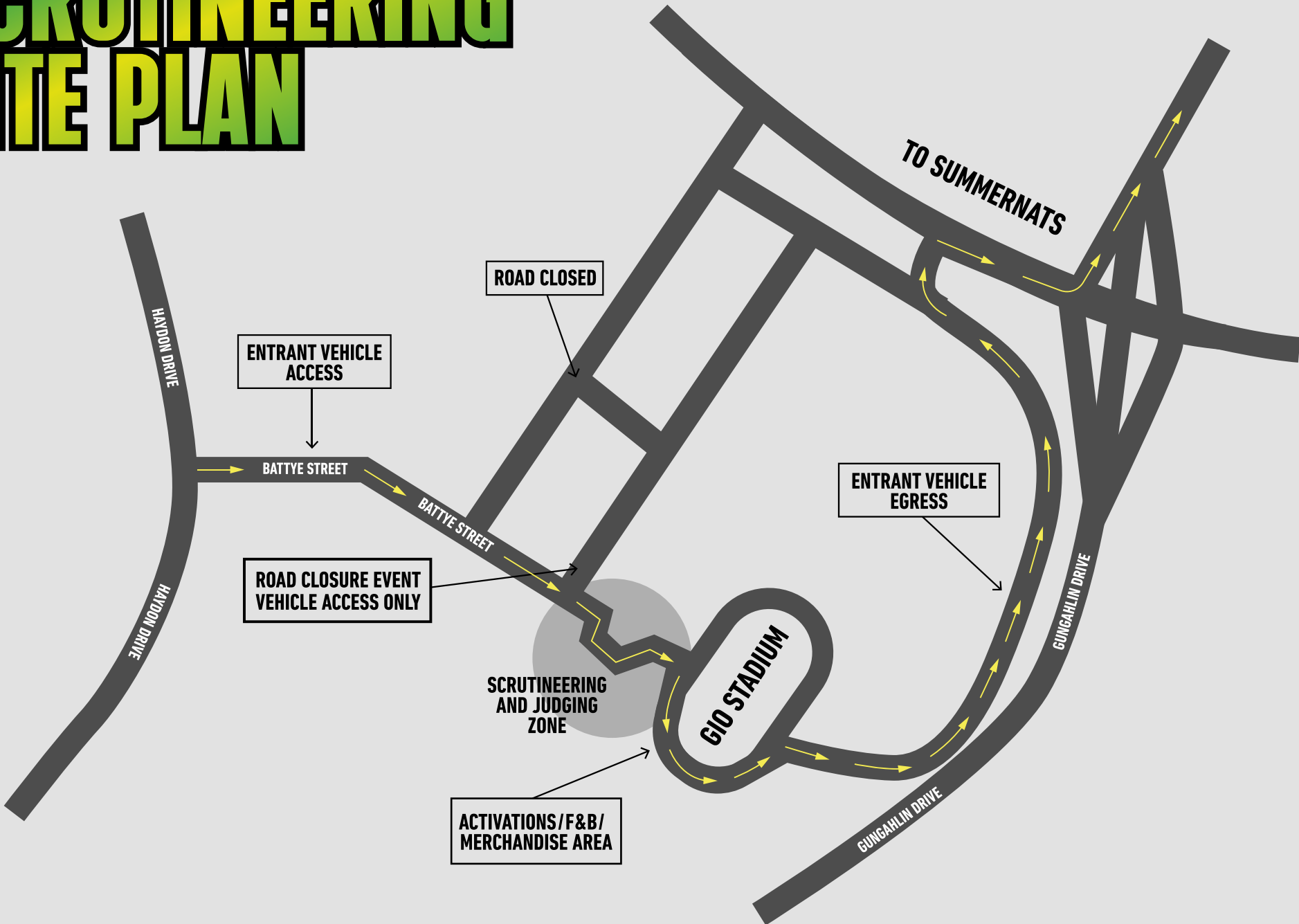
✗ DON'T

- Burnouts — we have a zero-tolerance policy and you risk losing your entrant rights
- Let anyone else drive your vehicle on the Cruise Route — only the entered driver is permitted to drive their car
- Drink and drive, or you will have the Police/Motorsport Australia to deal with RBT's will be in place
- Ride on the back of a ute
- Cruise in a support vehicle — ONLY entrant cars can cruise
- Bring your trailer on to the Cruise Route — park it in the dedicated trailer parking

BRADDON FRINGE FESTIVAL

WHAT

The Braddon Fringe Festival is an exclusive event to Summernats 36 and takes place on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.

The roads are open to approved Summernats entrants only, and closed to general public vehicles.

WHO CAN DO IT

Invitation only-passes for the Fringe Festival will only be given out to street-registered vehicles. All the normal road rules apply. You will receive an acceptance email prior to the event and your sticker will be issued at scrutineering.

Invited festival vehicles will form-up from 5:00pm on all three days.

CITY CRUISE



INFO

The City Cruise marks the official opening of Summernats and is a chance for select entrants to show off their ride to the city of Canberra. Participants drive in convoy from Exhibition Park into the centre of Canberra before a crowd of thousands, and then return to the venue.

WHO CAN DO IT?

City Cruise is invite only. You will already know if you've been selected. If you want to participate at Summernats 37, don't forget to nominate yourself when you enter!

FORM-UP

Form-up will be on the Main Arena from 9:00am. Make sure you're ready to go by 11:30am.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

A Compulsory drivers briefing is at 11:00am on the stage in the Main Arena.



DON'T FORGET!

THING TO REMEMBER

- Drivers briefing is compulsory for all drivers
- Follow the car in front
- All drivers and passengers in the vehicle must wear a seatbelt at all times, and must sit in a seat that is engineered for legal road use
- No drink driving — random breath testing will occur during form-up
- The City Cruise takes place on public roads — all road rules apply and are enforceable
- The City Cruise is a cruise, not a race or a burnout competition — drive safely
- Maximum cruise speed is 40km/h
- Have fun!

BURNOUT CHAMPIONSHIP



WHO

Entrants who have nominated for a Burnout time slot. After qualifying, the Top 40 will be invited back for Sunday's final. Entrants must be scrutineered for burnouts.

WHATS AT STAKE?

Prize money, trophies and bragging rights as the Burnout Championship Winner for the 2024 season.

WHEN

Burnout championship contenders have selected their elimination time on their application form. Be ready to go 15 minutes before your time slot — car in staging lanes, ready to go.

SAFETY FIRST

- **Fire suit** meeting or exceeding SFI 3.2A/5 or FIA 3356:2000 as a minimum, or other standards recognised by Motorsport Australia. Fire suit is **mandatory** for driver and passengers.
- Drivers and passengers must be wearing **closed toe shoes**.

MORE INFO, PLEASE!

It's their last chance to get into Australia's Biggest Burnout Grand Final – the Burnout Masters! Only three of these cars will take a spot in the already tight Masters field.

We've made the Wildcard Shootout at Summernats more merit-based. Wildcard qualifying spots have been awarded to the drivers who just missed out on scoring a spot for the main event at each of the qualifying events during the year.

Wildcard competitors that don't secure a place in the Top 3 will be eligible to compete in the Burnout Championship category, where you will be slotted into the elimination rounds.
